

Giuseppe Giordo

Chief Executive Officer of Alenia Aeronautica and Responsible for Finmeccanica's Aeronautics sector

Giuseppe Giordo was appointed Chief Executive Officer of Alenia Aeronautica and Responsible for Finmeccanica's Aeronautics sector in June 2010.

He is charged with defining the strategy, industrial alliances and managing the operations of the Aeronautics sector, which is comprised of 12,600 employees around the world with revenues of 2.8 billion Euro (over 4 billion Dollars).

In 2004, Giordo was appointed President and Chief Executive Officer of Alenia North America. As President and CEO of Alenia North America, Giordo was responsible for the company's strategies and operations, industrial investments and collaborations in both the U.S. and Canadian markets.

In February 2009, he was also given the responsibilities of Deputy-Chief Operating Officer of Alenia Aeronautica. As Deputy-COO, Giordo was responsible for the company's Military Airlift Division. Giordo oversaw the C-27J and G.222 refurbishment programs, including the related engineering, procurement, human resources, production, and support activities of these programs and the associated facilities.

Giordo oversaw a significant expansion in Alenia's presence in the U.S., starting from an annual revenue of \$15M in 2004 and growing to \$300M in 2009. He was instrumental in the establishment of Global Military Aircraft Systems (GMAS), a joint venture with L-3 Communications, with responsibility for logistics and training support of the North American fleet of C-27Js. Within the civil sector, Alenia North America established Global Aeronautica, a joint venture with Vought Aircraft Company, to perform the integration and testing of 60% of the B787 fuselage. In 2007, Alenia, with its partner L-3, was awarded the Joint Cargo Aircraft program, which will provide 38 C-27J aircraft to the U.S. Air Force and National Guard. In 2008, Alenia was awarded its first contract directly with the Department of Defense to provide 20 modernized G.222 medium lift aircraft and associated systems to be transferred to the Afghanistan Air Force.

After joining the company in 1990, Giordo has held multiple positions in program management and business development of increasing responsibility.

Mr. Giordo currently serves as the President of the Assembly of Members of GIE/ATR. He also serves on the Board of Directors of Alenia Aermacchi, Alenia North America, Sukhoi Civil Aircraft Company and SuperJet International.

Born in Treviso, Italy in 1965, Giordo earned a degree in economics and then a degree in law. He served for three years in the Italian Air Force. Giordo is married and has two children.
