<p><b>Position Summary:</b></p> <p>The G222 Program Manager will lead a seven-person team directly overseeing the execution of the Afghanistan G222 foreign military sales (FMS) program. Duties will include working directly with the US Air Force Program Management Office, NATO Air Training Command-Afghanistan (NATC-A), a CLS subcontractor in Afghanistan, the G222 original equipment manufacturer (Alenia Aeronautica), and field service representatives in Kabul, Afghanistan to deliver, sustain and modernize the G222 fleet.
