Simone Maraini joined Alenia North America in September 2005 as Chief Financial Officer. In addition to this role, he holds the position of Chief Financial Officer of Global Aeronautica LLC, and served as secretary of their Board of Directors until October 2007. Alenia North America owns 50% of Global Aeronautica LLC, which is a limited liability company handling the integration of major components of the fuselage and related testing activities for the Boeing 787 program.

From February 1996 - November 1997, Simone worked for Finmeccanica S.p.A. in Rome, Italy. Finmeccanica, a multinational conglomerate world leader in the transport, energy and aeronautics industries, is Alenia North America's parent company. In this job, he worked as Export Credit Manager.
